# Teladoc for the whole family

Members can use Teladoc on behalf of, or with, a loved one, parent, or other family member they care for as part of their existing Teladoc account.



- Caregiver Services allows Teladoc members to add family members not covered by their health insurance plan.
- Care recipients are able to receive the same services that Teladoc provides for non-emergency care.
- Teladoc's three-way visit option means Teladoc members can be a part of their family member's care.



# ADD & AUTHORIZE

- To add a care recipient, the Teladoc member logs in to their account and adds the family member(s) they're caring for.
- Then they will upload any legal documents required, or, have the care recipient authorize them as a Caregiver.
- Once completed, either the Teladoc member (Caregiver) or care recipient can request two- or three-way visits, and talk with a doctor by phone or video.
- The cost for either a two- or three-way visit is always \$45.



- A prescription can be sent to the care recipient's pharmacy of choice, if medically necessary.
- Caregivers can share visit summaries with the care recipient's primary care physician and other providers.
- Caregivers can access the care recipient's record for any follow-up needed.
